WHEN WE'RE TALKING OF THIS MANY DEATHS TO CANCER, IT'S KIND OF A BANAL STARTING POINT FOR A STORY.

HOWEVER, FOR THE RELATIVES OF THE DECEASED THERE'S NOTHING BANAL IN THE ILLNESS, THE DEATHS, NOR IN THE LOSS THE RELATIVES FEEL WHEN THEIR LOVED ONES PASS AWAY.

I'VE BEEN FOLLOWING SOREN'S WORK WITH THIS STORY FOR QUITE A WHILE, AND I'M NOT ASHAMED TO ADMIT THAT THE "TRIAL PAGES" OFTEN DID BRING TEARS TO MY EYES. AFTER ALL IT WAS ALSO MY DAD'S FINAL YEAR THAT IS IN THESE PAGES.


OF CAUSE MY EXPERIENCE IS DIFFERENT FROM MY BROTHER'S. HE WAS, IN EVERY WAY, CLOSER TO OUR PARENTS, SO MOST OF THE HELP THEY NEEDED, AND MUM STILL NEEDS, RESTS ON THE SHOULDERS OF SOREN AND HIS WIFE.

AT HIS DEATH DAD LEFT A VOID, ESPECIALLY WITH MY MUM, BUT ALSO WITH US THREE CHILDREN AND OUR SPOUSES AND WITH THE GRANDCHILDREN. DAD WAS ACTIVE, LOVED LIFE AND HE WAS A PROVOCATEUR. IN POLITICAL DISCUSSIONS HE WOULD OFTEN TAKE THE OPPOSING VIEWPOINT. AS HE SAID: "IT'S HARD TO GET A GOOD DISCUSSION, IF YOU'RE IN AGREEMENT". HE LOVED PLAYING GOLF, READING, HUNTING, AND WATCHING FOOTBALL. HE AND I WERE, OF CAUSE, SUPPORTERS OF DIFFERENT TEAMS, AND WHEN OUR TEAMS HAD PLAYED A MATCH AGAINST EACH OTHER, THE ARGUMENTS BETWEEN US WERE HEATED. THE THING I MISS THE MOST, MIGHT BE THE MANDATORY, AND TEASING PHONE CALL I WOULD RECEIVE EVERY TIME HIS TEAM BEATS MY TEAM.






THIS IS THE STORY OF MY DAD'S LAST YEAR STRUGGLING WITH THIS DISEASE.








WHEN DAD WAS NOT ON THE GOLF-COURSE,




A collapse in the back is also called a compression fracture in the back.


The reason for the fracture is that a vertebra is compressed. It is a very common condition among the elderly, especially among people with osteoporosis.

In addition to the fracture being painful, the function of the back is impaired.

THE TREATMENT FOR BOTH INVOLVED A LOT OF PILLS.
THE BLEEDING IN DAD'S BRAIN HAD TO SEEP AWAY BY ITSELF.
A NURSE AND A HOMECARE ASSISTANT WERE ASSIGNED TO ASSIST

SO MANY PILLS.





IT WAS THE TUMOR THAT HAD CAUSED THE HEMORRHAGE LAST FALL.





CT scan is a method based on X-rays and takes a few minutes.
Radiologists call it incision imaging, that is, "slices" of the brain of a predetermined thickness, usually 0.5-1.0 cm.

MRI scan is short for scanning using magnetic resonance.

If you need an MRI scan, you will be placed in a strong magnetic field.


By sending ordinary radio waves into the body and recording the echo, a computer can make a detailed picture of the body's interior.






DAD HAD A MEETING WITH THE DOCTOR, AND MY WIFE TINA WENT ALONG.

WHILE DAD WAS BEING DISCHARGED, TINA WENT HOME TO PICK ME UP.






I PUT ON MY JACKET IN A HURRY, AND WE DROVE BACK TO THE HOSPITAL TO GET DAD.
